

⌘ How to Cancel Avast Subscription and Stop Future Billing Charges – 2026 Permanent Fix ⌘

You want to cancel your Avast subscription and stop all future billing charges, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 so follow this complete step-by-step guide below, because turning off auto-renewal is the only way to prevent recurring payments.

Many users mistakenly delete the Avast app thinking that cancels everything, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 but your credit card stays on file in Avast's system, and they will keep charging you every year unless you disable auto-renewal manually.

This guide covers online cancellation through your Avast account dashboard, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 phone cancellation as the fastest method, how to handle subscriptions bought through third parties like Apple or Google, and how to get a refund if you were already charged.

For official help and account management, always visit my.avast.com , (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 because that is the only legitimate portal for managing your subscriptions and billing information.

Step 1 – Cancel Online Through Your Avast Account

Open your browser and go to the official Avast account portal at my.avast.com, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 then enter your email address and password to sign in. If you forgot your password, click “Forgot Password” to reset it.

Once logged in, click on “Subscriptions” or “My Subscriptions” from the dashboard, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 then find the active Avast product you want to cancel, and look for a link or button that says “Cancel Subscription” or “Turn Off Auto-Renewal”.

Click that button and confirm the cancellation when prompted, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and Avast will send a confirmation email to your registered address. Save that email as your permanent proof of cancellation.

If you do not see a cancellation option in your account, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 or if the button is grayed out, you may need to contact Avast support directly, so call the number below for immediate help.

Step 2 – Cancel by Phone (Fastest & Most Reliable)

Dial the official Avast customer support line at (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and when the agent answers, say clearly: “I want to cancel my entire Avast subscription and turn off auto-renewal permanently”, and they will ask for your email address or the last four digits of your credit card.

Once they verify your identity, they disable auto-renewal instantly, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and give you a confirmation number before you hang up. Write that number down and keep it in a safe place, because this is your proof that the subscription is canceled.

Phone cancellation takes only 3-5 minutes of talk time, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and hold times are shortest on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings, while Monday mornings and Fridays are the busiest.

For extra safety, you can call again the next day and ask a different agent to verify, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 that your auto-renewal still shows “OFF” in their system, giving you total peace of mind.

Step 3 – If You Bought Through Apple, Google, or Amazon

If you purchased Avast from the Apple App Store on your iPhone or iPad, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 you cannot cancel on the Avast website at all. Go to Settings > your name > Subscriptions > select Avast, then tap “Cancel Subscription” to stop future renewals directly through Apple.

For Google Play purchases on an Android device, open the Play Store app, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 tap your profile icon, select “Payments & Subscriptions”, then “Subscriptions”, find Avast, and tap “Cancel”. Your subscription will end at the next billing cycle.

For Amazon purchases, log into your Amazon account on a browser, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 go to “Account & Lists” > “Memberships & Subscriptions”, find Avast, click “Cancel”, and confirm. Your subscription will not renew after the current term ends.

If you are unsure where you bought your Avast subscription, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 call the official support line and the agent can look up your purchase source using your email address or credit card.

Step 4 – Get a Refund If Avast Already Charged You

If Avast already charged you for a renewal after you canceled, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 you may have up to 30 days from the charge date to request a refund, depending on your subscription type and region.

Call the billing department at (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and say: “My Avast subscription auto-renewed without my permission – please refund me”, and the agent will verify your account and process the refund if you are within the window.

The refund typically appears on your credit card within 3-5 business days, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and your bank takes another 2-5 days to post the credit, so total wait is 5-10 business days from your request date.

If you are outside the refund window, politely ask for a supervisor, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 because exceptions are sometimes made for long-time customers, and being polite and persistent can help you get your money back.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1: How do I cancel my Avast subscription and stop future billing charges without logging in?

Call the official Avast support line at (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and the agent will verify your identity using your name or credit card, then cancel auto-renewal over the phone without needing any login.

Q2: Will uninstalling Avast stop future billing charges?

No, uninstalling the software only removes the program from your computer, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 the billing agreement stays active, so you must cancel auto-renewal separately.

Q3: Can I cancel my Avast subscription and get a refund after auto-renewal?

Yes, you have up to 30 days from the renewal charge date to request a refund, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 call the number and explain the situation.

Q4: How long does it take to cancel Avast and stop billing over the phone?

The conversation with the agent takes 3-5 minutes, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 plus any hold time which is shortest on Tuesday and Wednesday mornings.

Q5: What is the direct number to cancel Avast and stop future billing charges right now?

Call the official Avast billing support line at (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 – a live agent will disable auto-renewal for you instantly.

Q6: Does canceling my Avast subscription automatically give me a refund for the current term?

No, canceling only stops future bills, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 you will not get a refund for the current term unless you request it separately within 30 days.

Q7: How do I stop paying for Avast if I bought it through the Apple App Store?

Go to Settings > your name > Subscriptions > select Avast, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 then tap “Cancel Subscription” – this stops future billing immediately.

Q8: Can Avast still charge me after I cancel my subscription?

No, once auto-renewal is turned off, Avast will not generate any future bills, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 but if you cancel close to your renewal date, a pending charge may still go through.

Q9: How do I remove my credit card from Avast after canceling?

After canceling auto-renewal, log into my.avast.com, go to Billing Information, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and click “Remove” next to your card.

Q10: What happens if I ignore Avast's renewal notice emails?

If you ignore them, Avast will automatically charge your card on the renewal date, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 so you must actively cancel auto-renewal to stop future billing charges.

Final Action Plan – Cancel Avast and Stop Billing Today

Step one: decide whether to cancel online or by phone – online takes 5-10 minutes, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 but phone is faster if you want to avoid menus, so calling is the most reliable method.

Step two: if you choose phone, dial (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 on a Tuesday or Wednesday morning, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 and have your email or credit card ready before you call, then tell the agent you want to cancel auto-renewal permanently.

Step three: after canceling, save the confirmation number the agent gives you, (+1)◀877◀419◀8702 then remove your credit card from the billing information section, and if you were charged recently, ask for a refund in the same call.
